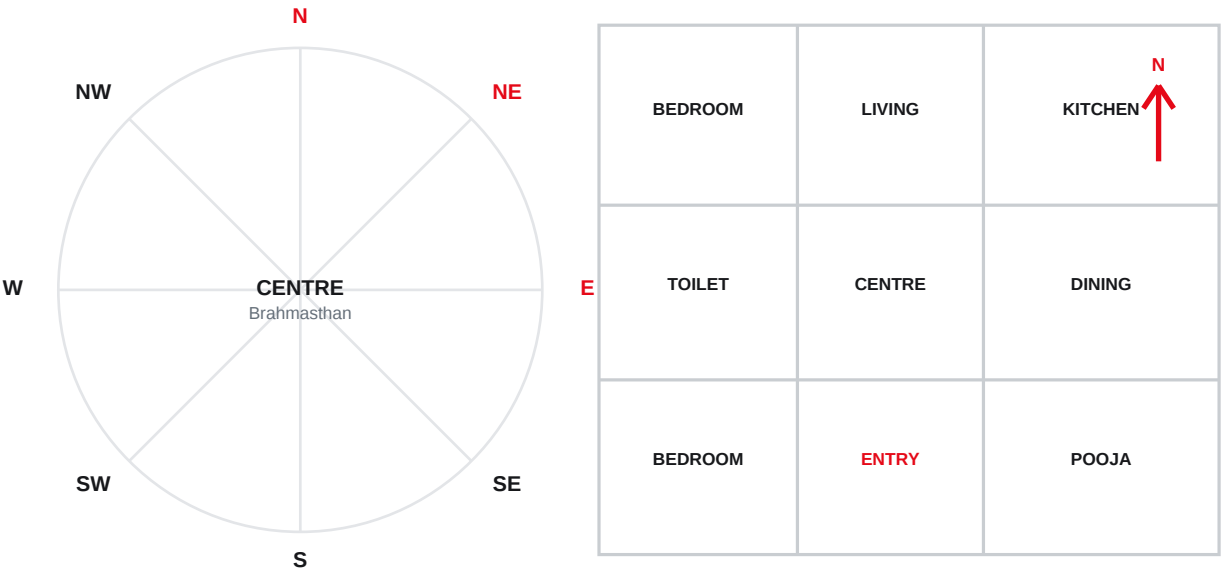
AREA	STATUS	OBSERVATION	ACTION
Main Entrance	Positive	Entry zone is broadly supportive in this sample layout.	Keep bright, clean and obstruction-free.
Kitchen	Good	Fire zone is reasonably aligned.	Maintain separation of fire and water elements.
Master Bedroom	Attention	Sleeping orientation may need correction.	Adjust bed direction where practical.
Toilet	Priority	Sample placement indicates a potential zone conflict.	Use practical non-demolition remedies.

Priority note: Address functional corrections first. Structural changes should only be considered where genuinely necessary and after professional architectural/engineering review.

PROPERTY ORIENTATION

Direction and zone mapping.

Vastu analysis starts with the correct North marking and a reliable floor plan. The diagram below is illustrative only and is included to show how the final report can explain spatial observations visually.

ZONE	THEME	SAMPLE STATUS	PRACTICAL NOTE
North	Career / flow	Good	Keep open, light and clutter-free.
North-East	Clarity / pooja	Good	Suitable for calm, prayer or meditation.
East	Health / activity	Good	Encourage natural light and ventilation.
South-East	Fire / kitchen	Balanced	Keep heat/fire activity concentrated here where possible.
South	Stability	Moderate	Avoid excessive openings or heavy disturbance.
South-West	Master zone	Attention	Prefer heavier furniture and stable usage.
West	Support / gains	Balanced	Maintain organized storage and functional use.
North-West	Movement	Balanced	Suitable for guest or movement-related functions.

ROOM-WISE ANALYSIS

Detailed observations by area.

The final client report should translate technical zone observations into simple decisions. The sample below uses a three-level priority system: Positive, Attention and Priority.

AREA	STATUS	OBSERVATION	RECOMMENDATION
Main Entrance	Positive	Entry is placed in a supportive zone in this sample.	Use clean signage, good lighting and a clutter-free threshold.
Living Room	Positive	Good openness and family-use placement.	Keep heavier furniture toward South/West where feasible.
Kitchen	Positive	Fire activity is reasonably placed.	Position stove so the user can preferably face East; avoid direct sink-stove conflict.
Master Bedroom	Attention	Bed orientation is not ideal in the sample layout.	Prefer head toward South or East where practical; reduce mirrors facing the bed.
Children / Guest Room	Balanced	Usable zone with no major concern in this sample.	Keep study direction and storage layout organized.
Toilet	Priority	Sample toilet position creates a potential Vastu conflict.	Use non-demolition balancing measures; keep dry, ventilated and closed when not in use.
Pooja / Meditation	Positive	Calm zone is reasonably supportive.	Keep area clean, quiet and visually light.
Centre / Brahmasthan	Attention	Centre has moderate visual/heavy use.	Reduce heavy storage and keep the central circulation open.

Interpretation: An Attention item means a correction is worth considering; it does not automatically mean demolition or a structural change is required.

VASTU DOSH CHECK

What needs attention first.

This section prioritizes identified concerns so the client can act in a sensible order. Severity should be assigned only after reviewing the actual floor plan, directions and usage.

01	Toilet in sensitive zone Why it matters: Potential zone imbalance Suggested action: Prioritize cleanliness, ventilation and a suitable balancing remedy; avoid unnecessary structural work without proper review.	High
02	Master bed orientation Why it matters: May affect rest quality in traditional Vastu interpretation Suggested action: Re-orient bed if feasible; prefer head toward South or East.	Medium
03	Heavy centre usage Why it matters: Centre feels visually blocked Suggested action: Reduce permanent/heavy storage and improve movement through the centre.	Medium
04	Fire-water proximity Why it matters: Elemental conflict if stove and sink are too close Suggested action: Create separation using counter space or a neutral divider where practical.	Low

PRACTICAL REMEDIES

Improve balance without unnecessary demolition.

Dazzle Space can present remedies in three levels so clients understand what can be done immediately, what can be adjusted later and what requires specialist review.

LEVEL 1 - IMMEDIATE

No-cost / low-cost housekeeping and usage changes

- Keep the entrance bright, clean and unobstructed.
- Reduce clutter in the centre of the property.
- Improve ventilation, dryness and hygiene in toilet areas.
- Reposition movable furniture to support better functional zones.

LEVEL 2 - PRACTICAL ADJUSTMENTS

Furniture, layout and simple balancing measures

- Adjust bed and workstation orientation where feasible.
- Create practical separation between fire and water elements.
- Shift heavy storage toward more suitable stable zones.
- Use calm lighting and clear visual organization in sensitive areas.

LEVEL 3 - SPECIALIST REVIEW

Only where layout limitations remain significant

- Consider architectural changes only after cost-benefit review.
- Check structural, electrical, plumbing and legal implications before modification.
- Use qualified professionals for any structural or services work.
- Treat Vastu guidance as advisory rather than a guarantee of outcomes.

ACTION PLAN

A simple order of implementation.

Clients should be able to read the report and immediately understand what to do next. This sample action plan keeps the sequence practical and measurable.

1	Today	Declutter entrance and centre; improve toilet ventilation and dryness.
2	This week	Recheck bed, desk and stove orientation; make furniture-level corrections.
3	Within 30 days	Complete low-cost balancing measures and review how the space functions.
4	If still needed	Book a consultation for complex issues or structural limitations.
